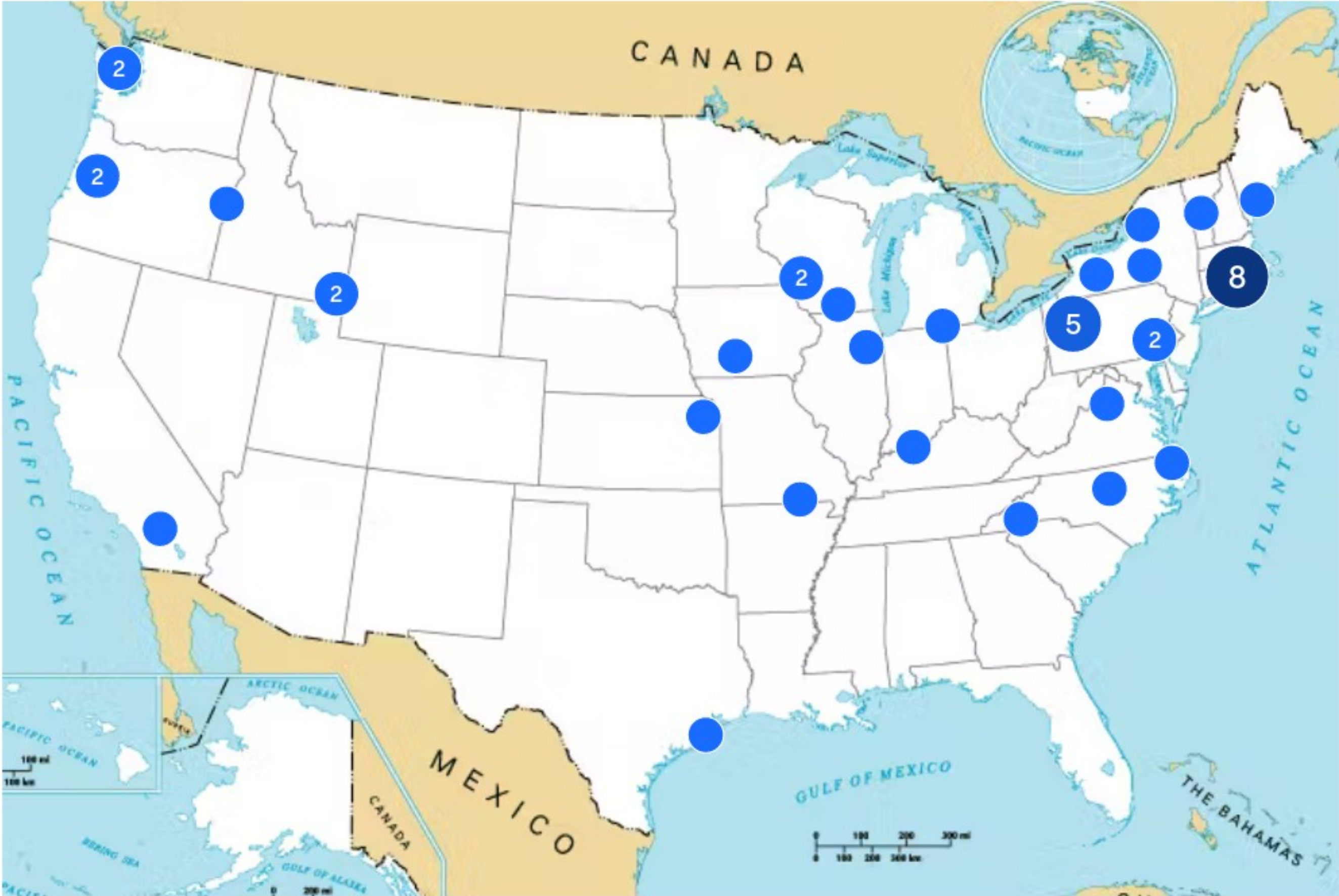

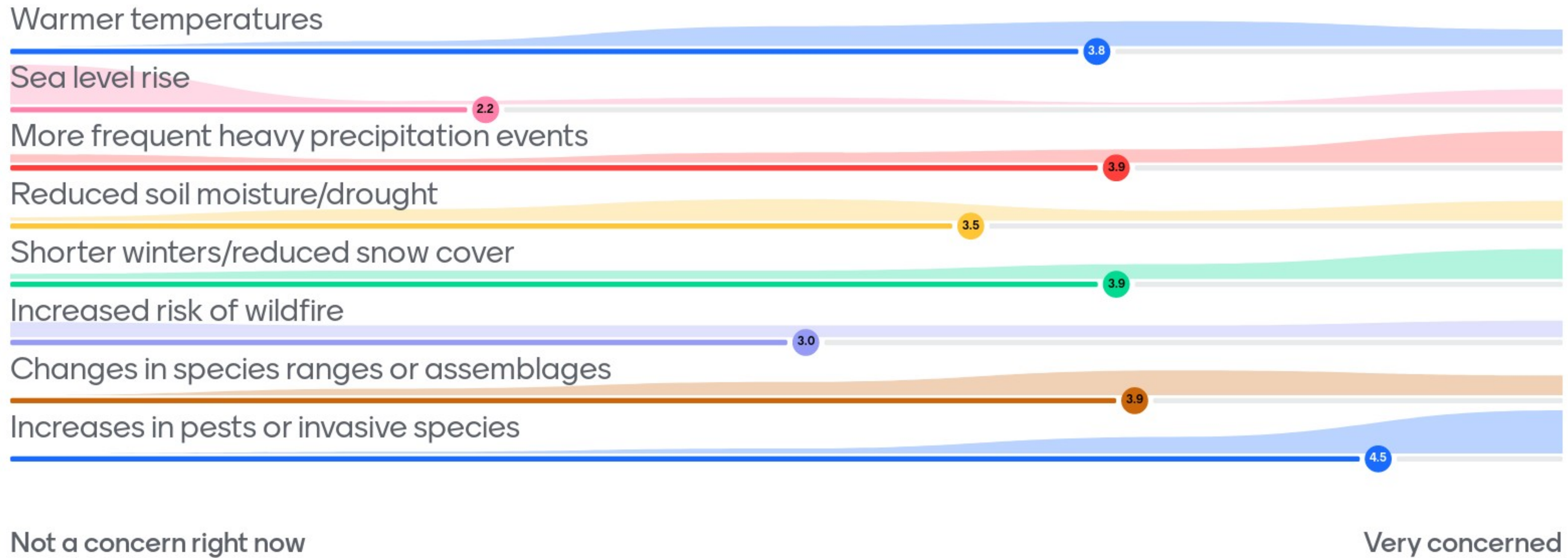

Tell us about the following climate impacts in your region...

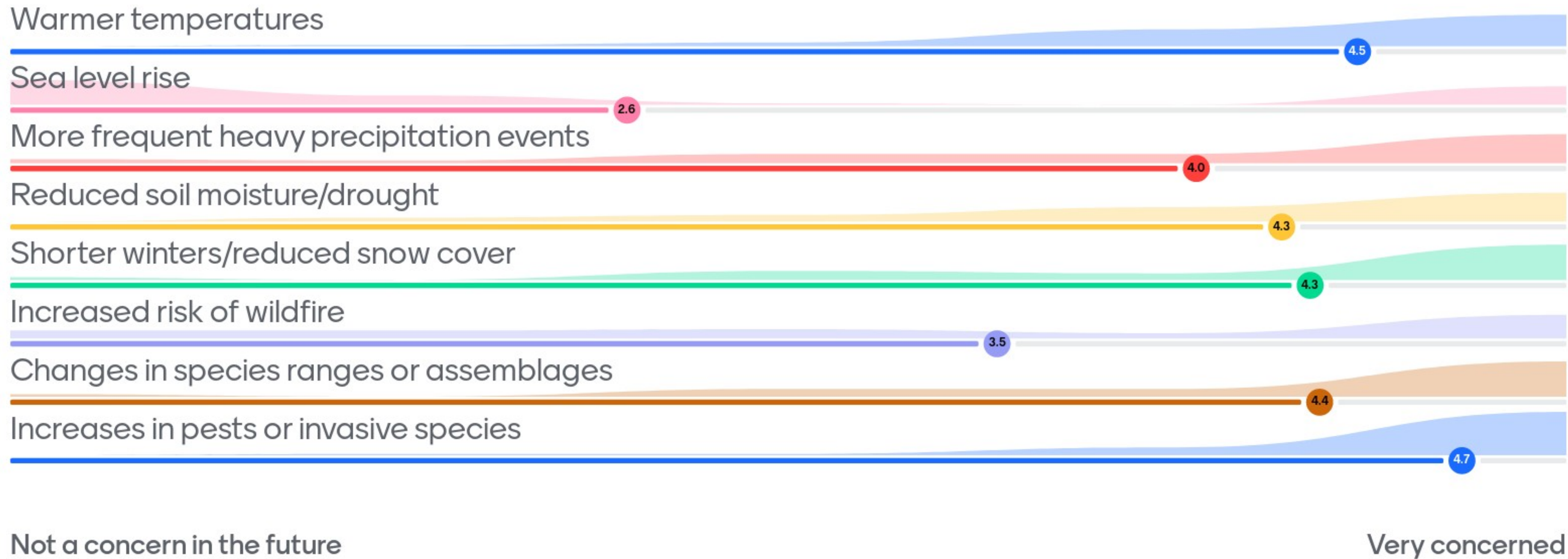
Climate Impacts: Now vs. Future

How are you currently integrating climate change into your work?

Reactive if at all

We think about it a lot but have not incorporated much into our work flow

Providing resources to farmers, adding biochar to soil

Planning, reemphasize priorities

Larger surfacing materials. More focus on managing extreme precipitation

Currently not integrating

Preserving old growth forest, especially around headwater streams and in watershed.

Integrating future marsh migration into conservation strategies and priorities

How are you currently integrating climate change into your work?

Most of our conservancy's goals include a climate change perspective.

developing educational resources

Into forest health planning and strategies

Setting strategic goals to align with climate resilience

We conserve forests; considering different tree species; studying/learning about climate impacts for decision making

Resiliency scores for land protection. Educating landowners

Restoring resilient coastal ecology.

Riparian area restoration and protection, prairie restoration, restoring estimated historical fire interval and intensity.

How are you currently integrating climate change into your work?

Integrating climate adaptation into property management plans.
Managing for species range shifts.

Making sure vulnerable farm land is protected and easements are flexible enough to allow for adaptation.

Urge our org. to adopt forest management. Focus on Invasives.

Land protection from development, planting more prairie, restoring/creating wetlands.

Adjusting species composition in restoration projects and thinning trees with future climate conditions in mind.

Focus on improving resilience of natural communities

Noting site condition changes over time and pursuing FMPs that have a climate adaptation component.

Uhhh...

How are you currently integrating climate change into your work?

Closing/relocating trails, prioritizing invasive species removal and control, tidal marsh restoration, more focus on riparian land protection, assisted migration (growing interest)

CC impacts are considered in land deals and recently had a strategy session to get more engaged in stewardship and management in future

we could do better...we have some current offset programs. we would like to learn how to do better tree planting events

Increased communication with social media and newsletter. Looking at climate models to integrate in conservation easement project selections.
